

## Set Up an Email Account on iPhones iOS7 or higher

For Apple iPhone with iOS 7 or higher.

Learn how to set up an email account to send and receive email with your iPhone.

### GENERAL SETUP

1. Open the settings and tap **PASSWORDS & ACCOUNTS**.  
if you are using iOS 10.3.3 or older, under Settings, tap **MAIL > ACCOUNTS**.
2. Tap **ADD ACCOUNT > OTHER**.
3. Tap on **ADD MAIL ACCOUNT**.
4. Enter your account details and tap **NEXT**.

### ACCOUNT DETAILS

FIELD	INPUT
Name	The name others will see when receiving your mail.
Email	The complete email address of your 1&1 IONOS email account.
Password	The password you entered when setting up the 1&1 IONOS email address.
Description	Enter a description for your account here. This information is only used to better differentiate your account from one another.

## SERVER SETUP

1. Receive your mail using the IMAP (recommended) by entering the respective host name for Incoming Mail Server.
2. Enter the remaining data and tap NEXT.

### INCOMING EMAIL SERVER

FIELD	INPUT
Hostname	imap.ionos.co.uk or (recommended) pop.ionos.co.uk
Username	The full email address of your 1&1 IONOS email account
Password	The password you entered when setting up the 1&1 IONOS email address

### OUTGOING EMAIL SERVER

FIELD	INPUT
Hostname	smtp.ionos.co.uk
Username	The full email address of your 1&1 IONOS email account
Password	The password you entered when setting up the 1&1 IONOS email address

#### Please Note:

- The email account is automatically set up with SSL encryption. The device performs the correct configuration in the background. You no longer must set anything manually.
- The SSL settings can also be checked later. For more information, see [Enabling SSL encryption on your iPhone/iPod/iPad](#).

#### Synchronisation Options

Select which data (mail, notes) you want to synchronise and confirm with **SAVE**.

Your email account is now set up. You can now check your mailbox and send emails on your iPhone.
